Clicking the **Cancel changes to current record** button (the X button) on the toolbar will delete the changes just made to a record and the button will be grayed out. *Note: Each register type and ROM/IPL version has unique functionality. For a full description of a particular register field, please consult a register dealer or register manual.*

The **Close** button will close the Maintain Area and take the user to the main screen of the software.

The Exit button will close the entire software.

The Help button brings up the V7 Help Files.

A new feature has been added to V7.3.1.148 and above. Users now have a hidden option to toggle grid field masking on and off.

If the user prefers to enter a PLU code manually or to use a scanner, the user can turn the Field Selection option off by pressing and holding the **Crtl** (Control) key on the keyboard and then pressing the ~ (tilde) key. The tilde is found on the keyboard in the upper left next to the number "1" key. The option can be turned back on by following the same key sequence or by leaving the program area and re-entering. This is an advanced programming option.
