





# V7 Archive Agent

## Installation Instructions



If the v7install.exe file has been downloaded from the Internet, please search for the file name to locate it on your hard drive. If the install is from a CD, just click on the Version 7 Polling Install link. *Note: V7 Archive Agent is contained within the V7 Polling installation.*





1. The "Welcome" screen is then displayed recommending that all other running applications be closed before continuing with the setup. Click **Next**.
2. If you agree to the conditions listed, click **I accept the agreement**. Click **Next**.




3. The Information screen opens. Please read over the text carefully before clicking **Next**. Release codes for new packages are available online. For new codes on an existing system please email your company information, product version, and serial number to [sales@technology4retailers.com](mailto:sales@technology4retailers.com) or call Tri-Technical Systems 563-556-3556.
4. Then, select a destination for the software. It is recommended that the suggested location not be altered unless absolutely necessary. Click **Next**.





5. Select the components to install and from the drop down menu pick the type of install: Full installation, Compact installation, or Custom installation. Click **Next**.




6. To continue click **Next** or click **Browse** to select a different folder then click **Next**.
7. Select the additional tasks you want the Setup Wizard to perform while installing V7 Polling. Click **Next**.





8. Click **Install** to continue the installation or click **Back** to review or change any settings.



9. Installation will take a few minutes to start. Please wait.
10. Fill in the Registration information. If the software is already licensed, click in the box to the left of **Already Licensed – Please Skip**. Leave the check mark in the box in front of **Update Ad DII** if using polling and AIMsi Inventory. Click **Finish**.




11. If the preference to validate the report tables is checked, the window above will appear. Please allow the software to validate the report tables after installation. Click **OK**.



12. If the preference to validate report tables is unchecked in Step 10, type **Yes** to validate the tables immediately or **Later** to do it at a later time on the Report Validation screen on the left. Click **OK**.

13. After reading the Information screen on the right in Step 12, click **Next**.



14. Check **Run V7Polling.exe** to run the program immediately. Click the **Finish** button.



15. Now the V7 program can be opened by double-clicking on the new icon on the desktop or from the Quick Launch icon in the system tray or if in Step 14 **Run V7Polling.exe** is checked off, the V7 Polling screen will open automatically.




16. The software will open to the main V7 Polling screen if a valid V7 Polling release code has been entered.



17. Select **Archive Agent** from the Program Selector in the upper left. You will be prompted to enter a release code.



18. If a release code has not been entered previously, the screen above will open. Click **OK**.



19. Please email or fax your **Machine Identification** number to Tri-Technical Systems at [sales@technology4retailers.com](mailto:sales@technology4retailers.com) for the most efficient way of obtaining the **Release Code**. In

- your email, you should include your business name and the name of the cash register dealer from whom you purchased the software. If email is not available, call 563-556-3556 or fax 563-556-0405. Tri-Technical Systems will then generate a **Release Code** and email that code back to you.
20. Enter the code on the **Release Code** line and then hit the **Update Release Code** button.
  21. After the code has been entered and accepted by the program, click the **Close** button to enter the software.



22. The software will open to the main Archive Agent screen.

*Note 1: The **Machine Identification** is an automatically generated number that is unique to your PC. Tri-Technical Systems must have that number in order to generate a release code. The **Release Code** determines the **Serial Number** and **Date Range** within which the software can be used. The **Release Code** automatically updates this information; it cannot be edited.*

*Note 2: The computer's Date and Time must be accurate in order for the release code to be accepted by the software.*

End-Users should always contact their cash register dealers first with questions about the V7 Archive Agent software. If the dealer is unable to answer the question, support options are available.
